Our group, the Friends of the Murrough, have already reported this to Wicklow Planning Department as unauthorised development (also attached) and the Divisional Manager of NPWS Mr. Jim Moore.

We know from bitter experience how difficult it is to get these obstructions removed once in situ and so we are exploring every avenue and thought you might be able to help.

We would be most grateful if you could advise us if a Foreshore License is require for such development or if any other controls are relevant to your department.
